Temperatures hovered around 26 degrees Celsius / 78 degrees Fahrenheit, forcing a fire ban in August, throughout the province. No back-country travel was permitted. Water levels were low and continued to drop throughout the season. Fishing on the River did not change much, as a large majority of our Bass were caught in June, Walleye stayed steady throughout the season and bigger Pike were caught during the months of August and September.
