Modified Housekeeping Package

Hi, and welcome housekeepers 2012. It is our priority to be helpful and organized for your "Fishing Team", and early planning is a good way to start. We have cabins reserved for your adventure with a 6 person minimum per group. Our resort is not fully equipped for housekeeping, so please bring your own eating utensils and paper plates. We do have pots, pans available and barbecues

We certainly want to avoid any mishaps or personal injury during your stay. To help minimize this, captains will need to be assigned to boats ahead of time. Each boat will be looked at before and after your stay to ensure no damage has been done. Any damages will be subject to a fee. Captains will not be permitted to operate equipment under the influence of alcohol. One guide will be assigned to every 6 people in your group. These guidelines are for the safety of all concerned and delegates more responsibility, also adding to the longevity of our equipment. There are no price adjustments for anyone bringing their own boat, but we do provide a 50 liter gas allowance for the 3 days.

We are pleased to offer breakfast in the main Lodge between 7:30 and 9am on the first 2 days, as well as shore lunch prepared by our guides on day 2, in camp or out on the shoreline. The main Lodge is closed to housekeepers, though you are always welcome to knock and ask for any assistance you may require. The Clubroom is available for your use, for quiet recreation. Please keep any serious excitement confined to your cabin.

We will be enforcing our release policy, which is; all Smallmouth and Pike are to be released (except Pike for shore lunch). Walleye over 17.7" are also to be released. You are responsible to clean your own fish and adhere to the size regulations. All trophy fish must be released, and fiberglass mounts can be selected as an alternative for mounts. Some of our staff will be on hand to assist you with your catch. The deposit required is \$100 ea. 45 days in advance. Any dates not filled and deposited by that time will be made available to others on our waiting list.

Finally, we would like to say that we are very appreciative of those on our housekeeping packages. By fine-tuning a few details and keeping your group manageable, we are able to provide a better service. Your visit is very important to us as it gives us a chance to prepare for our full service clients, or allow some of our staff time off. It is our priority to provide you and your friends with excellent service, equipment and hospitality. See you when the fish are biting.....
